The assessment for the course will consist of an e-portfolio, which will be broken down into individual assignments that learners will be completing on a weekly basis. All learners will be required to successfully complete the e-portfolio by the end of the course, to gain the certificate.

WHAT WILL YOU DO ON THIS COURSE?

- ✓ **Discuss the** importance of promoting equality and inclusion in day-to-day practice in health and care settings, and how this can be achieved.
- ✓ Develop an understanding around the jobs and career pathways in the health and social care sector. Also, to consider the skills and qualifications needed for different areas of work in the industry.
