Kids Eat for free this Summer 2024

ASDA – kids eat free for £1 all day, every day with no adult spend required.

IKEA – kids get a meal from 95p daily from 11 am.

Morrisons – spend £4.49 and get one free kid's meal all day, every day. The offer excludes café specials.

John Lewis café – from 19 July until 8 September kids eat for free at John Lewis when you spend over £10 on an adult lunch.

Sainsbury's Cafes – kids get either a hot main meal or a 'lunch bag' for £1 with every purchase of an adult meal from 11:30 am every day.
